To make an economy bumper sticker:

- 1. Print on letter paper. If necessary, change printer setting to landsape (long horizontally). Scale if necessary, so horizontal line is about 1-1/2" from top
- 2. Cut along horizontal line.
- 3. Place a strip of 2" clear postal packing tape on back. Trim tape so it is about 1/4" larger than paper strip on all four sides.
- 4. Turn over and place a second strip of 2" packing tape to cover front, and leave about 1" left and right to attach to your car bumper, car window, dorm door, bulletin board etc.
